In April 2019, Two Shires Medical Practice and Kibworth Medical Centre merged GMS contracts and become South Leicestershire Medical Group. We have a combined list size of 26,000+ patients. We serve the population of Kibworth, Fleckney, Great Glen, Market Harborough and surrounding villages. Our main site is Kibworth Health Centre, and we also have 5 branch sites plus two small outreach minor illness surgeries in Medbourne and Hallaton.

We offer extended opening hours telephone consultations from 7.30am until 8.00am, Monday – Friday.

We have two Dispensaries in Kibworth, both of which are open from 8.00 am until 5.30 pm, Monday – Friday (except Bank Holidays and other national holidays). We dispense to patients in the surrounding villages and we also provide a free delivery service to all our Dispensing Patients.

Our GPs are involved in the education and training of doctors and Undergraduate Medical Students.
